The next stakeholder meeting associated with the Sugar Pine Bridge has been scheduled for Wednesday, November 1, from 1:00-4:30pm Pacific Time to provide an update on the Merced River hydrology study. The meeting will include an update of research activities performed since the last stakeholder meeting held May 17, 2017. It will also include initial discussions regarding what types of actions might be taken in and along the river (for example, riverbank restoration, engineered log structures, etc.) to lessen the hydrological impacts of Sugar Pine Bridge, and how we might ultimately gauge the success of these actions.
